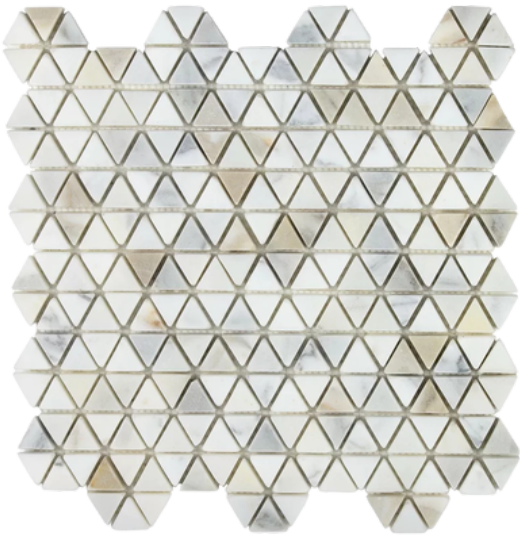


Quartz is a great option for kitchen counters. It's durable, resists stains and scratches and comes in a variety of colors

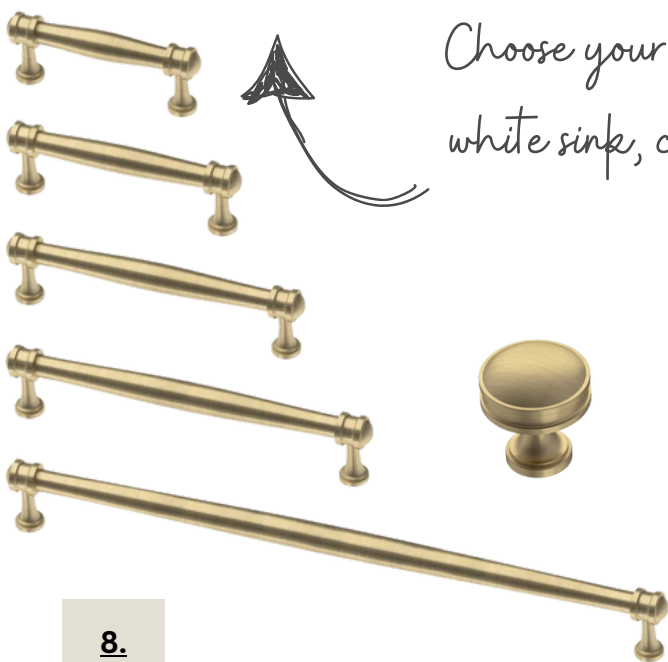
